HARBOR

Our private harbor has 124 berths ranging from 30 to 44 feet, and accommodates boats up to 46 feet long.

During 2008 the harbor will be dredged and the seawall will be replaced thus, increasing the overall size of our beautiful harbor.

DRY STORAGE

If you don't have room in your driveway for your boat trailer, don't worry, VYC has plenty of space on our locked lot to store your boat at a very affordable rate.

We also have a two ton crane available on the premises for launching dinghies and small sailboats.
